Subject: JORDAN, B-42117

On April 7, 1984 at approximately 1330 hours, I interviewed inmate JORDAN, B-42117 at his request in front of his cell. I asked him what he wanted to talk about.

He said, "About the Brooks killing".

I asked him: "What about it?"

He stated: I was the one that killed him all by myself.


I stated: Wait a minute BONVILLE already confessed to the killing.

He said: BONVILLE did not confess to anything, I did it by myself. It was a personel thing between BROOKS and myself and it had nothing to do with the B.G.F. I've known PINELL and BROOKS longer than any other inmate in this building and I did it by myself. After I killed him I walked along the fence line and threw the knife over the fence. I will not stand by and let my brothers get convicted for something they did not do.

I stated: Why are you telling me about this?

He stated: I want you to do what you have to.

On April 9, 1984 I contacted Investigating Lieutenant E. M. Morris about the conversation I had with JORDAN.
